

**Entrance requirements for foreign applicants who are already resid in Japan.**

This education course is meant for those planning to go on to institutes of higher education in Japan including universities, graduate schools and colleges.

Also, you may exploit your learning experience gained through our course in your daily life in Japan with your well-balanced "Reading, Writing, Listening and Speaking" capability.

**Qualifications required for admission**

- ① Applicants who have long-term residence qualification (excluding student visa);
- ② Applicants who are healthy in mind and body, capable of completing the course, and clear about their purpose in learning Japanese;
- ③ Applicants who have completed education programs of more than 12 years (comparable to high schools in Japan) in any country other than Japan; or

Applicants who have any qualification comparable to those above. Otherwise, please consult with us.

(If your term of study is less than 12 years due to the school system of your home country, please consult with us.)
