Guidelines for Applicants for 2024 Autumn Course

1. Course Details

2. Requirements

Applicants must:

- 1) have a definite objective in learning Japanese and a will to continue studying.
- 2) have a certificate demonstrating passage of the Japanese-Language Proficiency Test above level N5, the J.Test above level EF, or the NAT-TEST above level 5 by the time of application.
- 3) or have a certificate demonstrating learning of the Japanese language for 150 hours or more at an educational facility in the home country.
- 4) comply with Japanese laws and the rules of the Japanese Language Course of the Medical Esthetic College.
- 5) meet the requirements in terms of academic career and age:

Academic career: completed a 12-year course of study

- * It is almost impossible for those who have not completed a 12-year course of study in their home countries to enter universities or the equivalent in Japan.
- 6) have adequate financial resources to study in Japan.

3. Examination fee: 20,000 yen

4. Application must be made through a supporter in Japan

*Those who do not have any contact residing in Japan may consult with us.

* Supporter in Japan means a person who lives around Osaka and helps the student coming to Japan and prepares a stable learning environment as a guarantor when renting a residence.

Make a reservation by telephone first and come to the office in the main building. The documents will be checked by the office staff.

5. Applications accepted from March 01, 2024 until May 20, 2024

6. Tuition

^{*} In addition, about 40,000 yen will be necessary for textbooks during the 18-month period.

7. About Tuition Fee Exemption

The tuition fees mentioned in "No.6" will be waived as follows.

[7-1] OPEN CAMPUS Scholarship Card

Open Campus participants will receive an "OPEN CAMPUS Scholarship Card" and will receive an exemption of ¥80,000 on the first year's tuition.

[7-2] Guidance/Career Counseling Bonus Business Card

¥20,000 per card will be deducted from the first year's tuition. Up to 2 business cards can be used together. Therefore, up to ¥40,000 will be waived.

Procedure from Application to Entrance to College

1. Submit the application and required documents to the Japanese Language Course, Nishizawa Gakuen Medical Esthetic College.

*Be sure to make a reservation by telephone first and come to the office with the documents and the examination fee of 20,000 yen.

2. The application documents are examined by the College.

3. Notification of the result of the examination (scheduled date: mid-June to early July)

*The examination fee will not be refunded for any reason.

4. Payment of enrollment fee

*The enrollment fee of 100,000 yen must be paid by the guarantor (financial supporter) by the designated date.

5. Application to the Immigration Bureau

*Nishizawa Gakuen will submit the application documents to the Immigration Bureau and apply for a certificate of eligibility. The result will be made clear after approximately three months.

6. Notification of the issuance of the certificate of eligibility (scheduled date: early September)

- * The certificate of eligibility will be issued to the College, if the application is successfully accepted by the Immigration Bureau.
 - * The College will make notification of the result to the supporter in Japan. The supporter shall request that the guarantor pay the tuition.
 - * If the certificate is not issued (the application is rejected by the Immigration Bureau), the enrollment fee will be refunded in full.

Please note that the fee is not refunded if the applicant declines the enrollment for personal reasons.

7. Payment of tuition

*The guarantor (financial supporter) is asked to pay the tuition by the designated date.

8. The original certificate of eligibility is delivered to the supporter in Japan

*When the payment of tuition is confirmed, the College will contact the supporter in Japan and deliver the certificate of eligibility by hand.

*Because it is a very important document, the supporter is asked to send it to the applicant by registered mail.

9. Visa acquisition

*The applicant shall submit the certificate of eligibility and the letter of acceptance issued by the College to the Japanese Embassy or Consulate in his/her country to apply for a visa.

*If the applicant fails to obtain a visa, the tuition is refunded in full, but the examination and enrollment fees are not.
*Once the examination and enrollment fees are paid, they will not be refunded for this reason.

10. Arrival in Japan

*Successful applicants attend the entrance ceremony and orientation program in early October. The lessons start.
